

Front Lower Arm Bushings (Rear) Installation Instructions SPL FLBR Z34



SPL PARTS

Thank you for your purchase of this SPL Parts performance suspension product. Please follow these instructions exactly to ensure that the product is able to function to the best of its ability, and you can achieve the most performance out of your vehicle.

- 1. Press off the bracket that wraps around the bushing.
- 2. Press off stock bushing using appropriate bushing press and driver. For reference, we used a bearing removal tool to take the stock bushing off. (P/N: OTC 4518)
- 3. Press the new SPL Parts bushing onto the arm in the orientation shown below. Leave approximately 7/16 of an inch of the shank from the front of the bushing to lip on the arm exposed.



4. Press the bracket onto the new SPL Parts bushing. Be sure to press it in with the same orientation as the stock bushing so it will mount properly to the chassis. You may need to press the bushing onto the arm a bit more to get the bolt holes for the bracket to line up.





- 5. Measure the inner diameter of the bushings and the stud. The stud should be at least 0.001 inch thicker than the inner diameter of the bushing bore. If it isn't, knurl the stud some, and you can also add bearing assembly compound.
- 6. Be safe, and enjoy your new upgrade!
